Teachers College is pleased to offer TC Gmail for Life to alumni who have graduated from degree programs.* In order to access your TC Gmail you must have an active UNI. Recent graduates should be able to log into their TC Gmail account as normal. If you graduated over a year ago and have not logged into the myTC Portal since graduating, activate your UNI and TC Gmail by following the instructions below.

If you know your UNI but forgot your password, skip to PART C. If you want to learn more about email forwarding, skip to PART D.

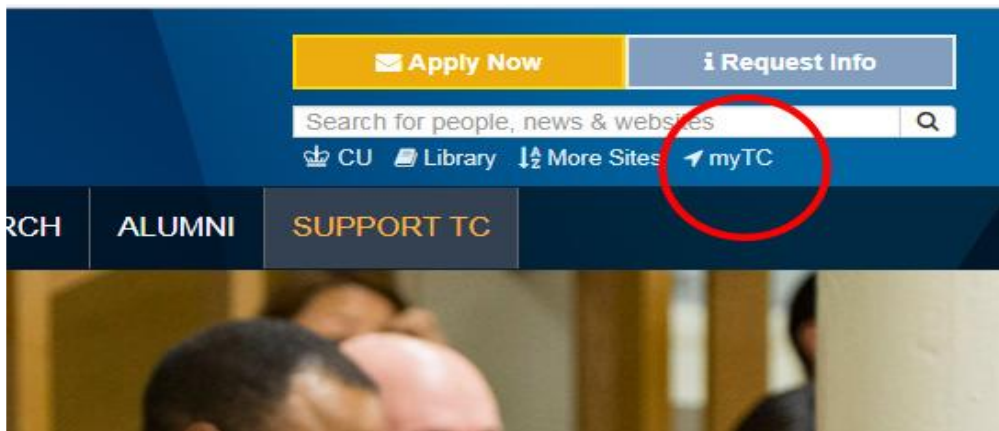

- Enter your UNI, or, if you don't know it, follow the prompts for “Don't know your UNI? Click [HERE](#) to activate.”



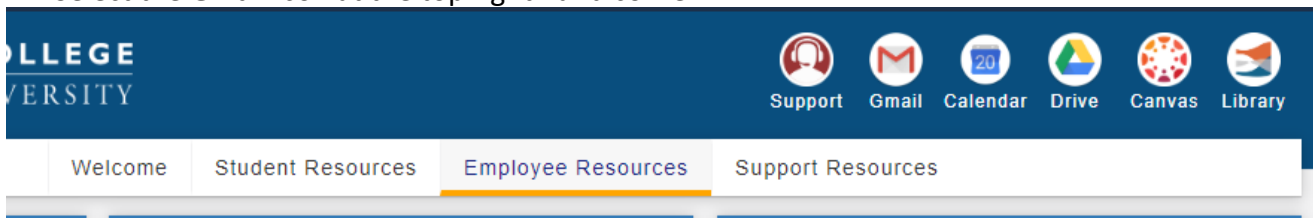
- Follow the prompts to retrieve/activate your UNI and set up your password. If you forgot your password, see PART C.

PART B: Access TC Gmail

- Once you have your UNI and password, visit www.tc.columbia.edu and select “myTC” on the upper right.



- Log in using your UNI and password.
- Select the **Gmail** icon at the top right hand corner.



- If it is your first-time accessing TC Gmail, you will be prompted to accept the terms and conditions.
